

# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip

6:00 PM- 9:00 PM - Show/Supper  
11:00 PM - Arrival at school

**Student cost of trip:** \$120 - Students will need to bring extra money for snacks and souvenirs if desired.

**Chaperone cost of trip:** \$145 - There is an increase due to adult pricing at aquarium and Medieval Times.

## Payment plan:

- Sept. 30-Oct 4**      **Student** deposit of \$60 is due to hold seat on bus. If no deposit is paid, the student will not be allowed to sign up at a later date. Money from fundraiser WILL be applied toward deposit. Balance can be paid in full.
- Oct. 14-18**          **Chaperones notified who can go on trip\***
- Oct 28-Nov. 1**      **Student** 2<sup>nd</sup> payment of \$60 is due. Balance has to be paid in full.
- Oct 28-Nov. 1**      **Chaperone** deposit of \$75 is due to hold seat on bus.
- Dec. 2-6**            **Chaperone** 2<sup>nd</sup> payment of \$70 is due. Balance has to be paid in full.

\* Parents, DO NOT send money for chaperoning. The number of chaperones will be determined by the number of seats available and school guidelines for selecting chaperones. If you are interested in chaperoning, please fill out the form below and return it with your child by Sept. 27. We will notify you and will expect a chaperone deposit no later than Nov. 1.

## These Rules Apply to the Field Trip

- \* **Please Note:** Once a payment is received, refunds WILL NOT be given after December 20th. This is based on the field trip company's policy. Once money is turned into the companies, they DO NOT give refunds.
- \* **Please Note:** At each deadline, your account has to be paid up-to-date. If you are not up-to-date on a payment, your child's seat can be given to someone on the waiting list.

This is an informational sheet, nothing needs to be turned in at this time unless you are interested in chaperoning. A reminder about the 1st payment will be sent home the week before payment is due.

## Reasons for being removed from trip

A student or chaperone may be removed from the field trip for not making payments. If a payment is not received by the deadline, students will be removed. The only money refunded is the \$50 deposit. We have deadlines to make to ensure we reserve out tickets.

According to school district policy AR IJOA-R a student who is not in good standing may be excluded from participation in a field trip. A student in good standing is defined as one who has the following:

- No out-of-school suspensions during the year
- No in-school suspensions during the current semester
- Appropriate (improved) attendance record for the year
- Met the academic requirements for competitive events under the EIA (failed no more than two subjects during the most recent reporting period)

According to WOMS policy, a student with multiple in-school suspensions or excessive absences during the school year may not be allowed to participate in the field trip. This is at the discretion of the school administration.
